

Good afternoon everyone!

Today the Premier announced whilst all public schools will remain open until the end of term, families are strongly encouraged to keep their children at home if they have the capacity to do so. I would like to share with you what this will mean for our school community:

Monday 30 March to Friday 3 April

- All children who attend school will be taught as normal.

Final week of Term – Monday 6 April to Thursday 9 April

- Students who attend will be supervised, but not taught normal lessons.
- Teachers and education assistants will prepare teaching programs for Term 2.

Term 2 – commencing Tuesday 28 April

- At this stage arrangements for Term 2 have not been finalised. The State Government is working on developing a longer term education model for Term 2 and beyond in response to COVID-19.

To support parents with home schooling, parents are able to access a comprehensive library of online resources organised in year level and learning areas, that the Department have developed. This link will take you to the site [learning from home resources](#)

As staff will only be supervising children in Week 10 we will be sending out a survey to parents to gain information on the children who need to be attending so we can develop a supervising plan.

We respectfully request that parents do not ask teachers for extra resources. As outlined previously, children can continue with their class text books and online programs.
