- HOT food needs to be delivered HOT, TO YOUR CHILDS CLASSROOM just before lunch at 12.45. (For food safety reasons, warm food that has been sitting for a longer period of time will be returned uneaten)
- Children will be provided with a disposable plate and eating utensils.
- Children are encouraged to wear their national or a pioneering costume on the day to celebrate our students' multicultural backgrounds.
- Please, no commercial "junk" foods.
